# Protos Community Benefit Fund Financial Statement 01 February 2023 to 31 March 2024

### **Protos Community Benefit Fund**

This report presents a Financial Statement for the Protos Community Benefit Fund (Protos CBF) for the period from 01 February 2023 to 31 March 2024. The previous annual Financial Statements have been for the year ending at end January. The reporting period for this Financial Statement has been extended to end March to align more closely with the financial year used by Peel, the sponsor of the Fund.

The principal activity of the Protos CBF is to provide funds for projects which benefit the local community. The Fund is run as a sub-committee of the Protos Community Forum and applications are decided by a panel of Parish and Town Councillors who represent the areas covered by the Forum. The work of the Fund is supported by a paid Secretary.

Panel meetings were held on 8 March 2023, 7 June 2023, 12 September 2023, 12 December 2023 and 12 March 2024. The Panel Chairperson changed from Cllr Sarah Temple to Cllr Andy Canham at the September 2023 meeting.

A payment of £50,000 was received from Peel on 21 Jan 2023 (shown in the previous Financial Statement to year ending 31 January 2023) and was allocated by the panel as shown in this Financial Statement. A payment of £50,000 was received on 27 March 2024 (shown in this statement) and the allocation of that contribution will be reported in the next Financial Statement.

The Panel and Secretary has struggled to engage the services of a professional Accountant since the last Financial Statement for year ending 31 January 2023. Therefore it was agreed at the Protos CBF meeting held 10 December 2024 that the Secretary should prepare a Financial Statement which the Panel could present for review and approval by the Community Forum. After approval by the Forum, the Statement will be made publicly available on the Protos website, as undertaken in previous years.

The Fund Secretary changed from Mrs Vicki Serna to Miss Jennifer Emmerson at the March 2024 meeting. This Financial Statement has been prepared by Cllr Sarah Temple

to support the current Secretary who was not in post during the period covered (01 February 2023 to 31 March 2024).
