The secretary presents her report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 January 2023.

Principal activity

The principal activity of the fund is the provision of funding for local community causes.

During the year a further £50,000 was made available to the fund and £48,464 was paid out in respect of applications received from members of the community.

With effect from March 2022 the individual fund limit was increased from £4,000 to £5,000.

As at the balance sheet date applications for a further £30,028 had been approved by the Benefit Fund Panel. This amount breaks down as follows:
